



Hello, Everyone! Thank you for entering the September 26-27, 2015 CPE trial hosted by AgileDogs Agility Training. This is your entry confirmation. Your individual entry confirmation should have already come in a separate email. Please be sure to look at it closely and let me know of any errors or move ups.

We are going to do our best to move the trial along efficiently while making sure everyone has a safe and successful run and gets their time in the ring. Walk throughs will be timed at 8 minutes all weekend long. We will be counting on our volunteers (thank you so, so much!) to help make the weekend go smoothly. Stockade Agility will be running a USDAA trial in the other ring. Please listen to both the general briefing in the morning and the judge's class briefings for ways we can make the trial run more efficiently and for any changes to the schedule and for information on how conflicts will be handled. We still have some runs available for both days so if you wish to add runs or know anyone who would like to enter please email chris@agiledogs.net before 9PM on Tuesday. We will not be taking day of show entries at this trial.

Awards:

Perfect weekend rosettes will be awarded to teams achieving Q's in all 8 runs.

Check-in, Measuring, and Starting Times:

Saturday: Check-in, day of show entries, and measuring, 7:00 – 7:30
General / Judges' briefing 7:30; First dog on the line immediately after walk throughs.

Sunday Check-in, day of show entries, and measuring, 7:15 – 7:30
General / Judges' briefing 7:30; First dog on the line immediately after walk throughs.

CATALOGS:

Only a few copies of the run catalog will be available at the trial. The catalog will be available for download and printing on Wednesday night at www.agiledogs.net.

There will be NO measuring of dogs AFTER the Judges Briefing begins each day – ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD MUST BE MEASURED before the Judges' Briefing in order to show that day – THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

VOLUNTEERS:

The volunteer schedule will be posted on the AgileDogs website by Thursday. Thanks to all who volunteered! If you want to volunteer or have questions, please email Lisa Norris, jumpinbeandogs@hotmail.com. Please do not worry about conflicts between classes you're working and classes you're running in. All workers will be accommodated. You can move your dog within a class to make sure you have time to concentrate on having a successful run with your 4-footed partner.

If your job for a given class is timer, scribe, assistant scribe, or gate steward, please report to the chief ring steward when the briefing for the class begins, so you can prepare for your job and so the judge can brief you if needed – thanks! If your job is anything not already mentioned, you can report any time before or during the walk through.

VENDORS, FOOD:

Lunch, snacks & drinks will be provided for volunteers and will also be available by donation for all others. We ask that you bring a refillable water container in order to help us in our quest to be green.

We will have Donna Kelliher as our photographer again this year. Please see her for any special requests.

MOVE-UPS - CLOSING DATE:

During the trial, move-ups in Standard will be taken at the show, and must be submitted to the Show Secretary before the completion of the last class of the day. Thank you for your cooperation.

The deadline for contacting the secretary with move ups or corrections before the trial is 9pm on Tuesday, September 22. Any changes to entries made after that date will be subject to a \$5 service change fee, no matter who made the error.

RULES: CPE has initiated new rules effective February 1, 2013; review the CPE website for details (www.k9cpe.com).

SITE DETAILS:

There will be garbage receptacles for dog waste, cigarette butts, and any other garbage. Please bring water for your dogs. There is very limited shade at the trial site so it is recommended to bring your EZ Up tents.

For the safety of our competitors there is a strict 5 MPH speed limit on the site grounds. Anyone who does not follow this strict speed limit will be asked to leave. The site may have horses on the property.

OVERNIGHT CAMPERS:

Campers should check in with either Pat or Paul Snyder upon arrival to be directed to their site. If you have a generator, we request that all generators be shut down between 10 pm and 6 am

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

Stockade Agility is located at 505 Sacandaga Road (Route 147) in Glenville, New York. Our driveway is directly across from Spring Road and has rail fencing on both sides of the drive.

From Route 29 (points north): Turn on Route 147 heading south. Pass through Galway, cross Route 67 and continue on Route 147 toward Scotia. Show is approximately 9 miles from Route 67, on the right.

From Route 67: Take Route 67 west from Ballston Spa / east from Amsterdam, to Route 147 (traffic light, Stewart's, big white church at intersection). Turn south on Route 147 and proceed 9 miles. Grounds are less than one mile (south) past Stewart's on route 147. Look for the blinking traffic light, Beukendaal Firehouse on the right. The Stockade driveway is just before the Beukendaal Firehouse on the right.

From I-90/Route 890 (points east): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 25 or other access) toward Rotterdam. Continue past Schenectady, Campbell and Rice Roads. Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn) 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway to Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left.

From I-90/Route 890 (points west): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 26 keep left after toll booths). Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn) 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway for Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left
